



## FAQ for the Sailfish Splash Aquatic Athletics Center FHSAA Swim Meet

Q: When can I enter the facility?

A: Coaches and Athletes can enter at 6:30am. The gate will open for spectators an hour prior to the start of preliminaries at 8am and finals at 4:30pm. All spectators, athletes and coaches must clear the competitive side of the facility prior to the start of warm-ups for the finals at 4:15pm.

Q: Do I have to pay to get in?

A: Yes, the cost is \$9 if you pre buy your tickets online or \$12 at the gate. You will need to purchase a ticket for both preliminaries and finals. You may purchase an all-day wrist band for \$24 at the gate when you arrive.

Q: Do I have to pay for parking?

A: Yes, the cost is \$10 per vehicle and the parking pass will be good for all day. You may use cash only. Coaches will receive a parking pass.

Q: How can I help?

A: Please visit the FSHAA website and sign up to become a volunteer to help time. Volunteers do not need to pay the gate admission, they receive a volunteer shirt and have access to the hospitality room.

Q: Can I park my RV at the facility overnight?

A: No, however Phipps Park Camp Grounds has overnight accommodations and is less than 7 miles away. Reservations can be made by calling 772-287-6565

Q: Will I be able to buy food at the facility?

A: Yes, there is a concession stand onsite as well as a food vendor on deck.

Q: Can I bring in a cooler or outside food?

A: Coolers and outside food is only allowed inside the Athlete's Area. Spectators will receive a wrist band after paying admissions and with that, you will be able to go to your vehicle as much as necessary. A bottle of water or a cup of coffee will be permitted. If you have a medication that must be refrigerated, please see a member of management. Also, no glass bottles will be allowed on deck.

Q: Can I bring in stadium or deck chairs?

A: Stadium/bleacher chairs are permitted. Deck chairs are not permitted in the spectator area. Coaches and athletes may bring deck chairs in for their team use only.

Q: Can I sit with my child who is competing?

A: Parents are not allowed in the Athlete's Area.

Q: Can I bring my pet?

A: Only registered Service Animals will be allowed in. The service animal must have its vest and you will be asked to show documentation. Under no circumstances should you leave your pet in your vehicle.

Q: Is there an ATM on property?

A: No, the facility does take Cash, Visa, Discover, Master Card, and American Express.

Q: May I smoke or use an electronic cigarette inside the facility?

A: No, you must leave the facility and be 50 away from the gate prior to smoking.

Q: May I bring alcohol in the facility?

A: Alcohol is not permitted inside the facility or in the parking lot.
